

Creative Classroom Activities

1. Turn your class into The Great Adventures of Little Marlon Day. The classroom can center on a book. The classroom's door could be decorated on the theme or an aspect of a book. There can be an area for boys to display how to be gentlemen. In that area, girls are catered to. In another area, kids can learn conflict resolution. The possibilities and the fun are endless!
2. Have The Great Adventures of Little Marlon dress-up day. Let each student pick their favorite character to dress as. Activities could include a parade and students can write/tell about the character.
3. Students can make their own The Great Adventures of Little Marlon museum. The students could dress as their favorite characters, or assigned characters, and attach a paper button to their costumes. Invite other classes to the museum. When the other kids push their 'buttons,' the 'wax' students can recite something about their character and the book it is in.
4. Students can dress as characters and perform a play of a The Great Adventures of Little Marlon book.
5. Boys and girls write and verbally express one reason that the other is not yucky.
6. Boys carry girls' lunches to the lunch table, sharpen their pencils, and pull out their seats for a day.
7. Have a contest to see what great ideas your students come up with!
